






Carl is currently Music Director, organist and cantor at historic St. Gabriel Catholic Church in the Canaryville neighborhood of Chicago, Illinois. Prior liturgical work included organist at Santa Lucia Parish in Chicago, St. Mary's Parish in Riverside, Illinois and Music Director at Unity Church of Oak Park. Carl has been a performer and music professional for forty plus years, playing the organ since he was seven years old. Carl has performed as organist for various special events at Orchestra Hall, The Chicago Theater, the Arcada Theater in St. Charles and the former Medina Temple. Carl is locally known in the Western Suburbs of Chicago for his live organ playing at roller skating rinks, was house organist at the Orbit Skate Center in Palatine, Illinois for fifteen years and is currently organist at the Aurora Skate Center. Carl's organ music is frequently heard on Midwest Ballroom aired on WDCB radio, 90.9 FM. He also performs as a keyboardist and vocalist with music partner Kenned MacIver, an association that has continued for three decades, resulting in many concerts, fund-raisers and events for churches, businesses and charitable organizations. As a result of this association, Carl has created innumerable keyboard arrangements of classic standards, pop music, Broadway show music, country music and Latin, as well as inspirational/sacred music. Kenned & Carl have released a number of CD's including To God Be The Glory, Old Friend, But Beautiful, Speak to Us and Kenned & Carl: Broadway. Carl has performed for socials at the Coronado Theater in Rockford; JATOE (Joliet Area Theater Organ Enthusiasts) at the Rialto Theater in Joliet; CATOE (Chicago Area Theater Organ Enthusiasts) at the Tivoli Theatre in Downers Grove and St. John Cantius Church in Chicago; and for the CTOS (Chicagoland Theater Organ Society.)

Lori Moreland is a Chicago based professional organist and pianist who has performed throughout the United States. Born and raised in Fort Wayne, Indiana, Lori was introduced to the organ by her father. At the early age of 7 years old, her musical abilities on both the organ and piano blossomed and ultimately became the focus of her life's work. Lori received classical organ instruction at the world-renowned American Conservatory of Music in Chicago and has dedicated much of her career to sacred church performance. In addition, her experience has expanded to many genres of music; including rock, orchestral and solo piano and keyboard performances. As a result, Lori has performed for and garnered praise from music giants such as jazz great George Shearing, Paul Williams, composer and conductor Marvin Hamlisch, Richard Carpenter and American television personality and musician Steve Allen. Lori's latest accomplishments include guest appearances with *The Chicago Bulls* and *The Indiana Pacers*. However, Lori Moreland is best known as the organist for *The Chicago White Sox*. She resides in Northwest Indiana and is the proud mother of two grown sons.

#### VTPO News, Is It or Isn't It?

I'll start our Virtual club off this year with my virtual theater pipe organ. Here is a little history of the Wurlitzer opus 493 model 235 that was shipped to the Indiana Theater in Terra Haute on 11/20/1921. It was a panel style 3 manual, 11 rank organ with a piano addition. United Artist chain sold the organ to Richard Ertle when the theater closed. He took it to Vincennes and put it in a barn and basically let it rot on a dirt floor. Most of the components were ruined. A local Indianapolis organ technician who was sent by the local ATOS Chapter to inspect the organ and purchase it for a project in Indianapolis, passed on the organ and Roy Davis an organ broker in Tennessee bought it and parted it out. When I talked to Roy, he didn't remember who he sold the console to. Carlton Smith sent me the original ad Roy posted to sell the organ. Now I find this Model Wurlitzer for sale by

Scott Smith in Michigan. This organ he bought at a "garage sale". It belonged to the late Bill Milligan who suffered a heart attack in his 50's. Scott found a shoe box with all the original stop tabs and it was a early Wurlitzer panel style model 235 with a piano addition. I found it interesting that everything Roy listed in his ad that the organ was missing, this organ had missing too. From talking with Scott, Carlton and Terry Kleven, they all seem to think that this was the Indiana Theaters organ, but can't recall why they all came to the same conclusion. Too much time has passed. It started in 2004 and made its first sound in 2011, I believe. Many had helped in making my dream come true. Rick McGee in Atlanta Georgia rebuilt the keyboards and stop rails. He also made the two trays and toe piston tiers. Joe Fisher helped with all the technical stuff inside and bought it to life. I learned a lot about electronics from Joe. It runs the Hauptwerk program, has 12 channels of audio and many organs, both theater and classical installed. Even with the gap in the history of this Wurlitzer, this will someday return to the Indiana Theater in Terra Haute Indiana. I believe it is their Wurlitzer Opus 493, that is until anyone can prove it's not.
